THE MIGORI COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2023

A Bill for

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Migori, to provide for various levies, fees and charges for services, and for other revenue raising measures by the County Government and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Migori, as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Migori County Finance Act, 2023 and shall come into operation on the seventh day after the date of publication in the *Kenya Gazette*. The County Executive Committee Member for Finance may through a notice in the County Gazette appoint different dates for various provisions.

PART II—INTERPRETATIONS

Interpretation

2. In this Act the following terms have the following definitions assigned to them—

"Administrative ward" shall denote areas represented by Member of County Assembly;

"Business" means—

- (a) Trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (b) Any other activity in the nature of trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (c) Any activity carried on by a person continuously or regularly, whether or not for gain or profit and which involves, in part or in whole, the supply of goods or services for consideration.

"Business Code" means unique code issued to every class of source of revenue stream for the purpose of revenue collection;

"Cess" means tax or fees chargeable on certain goods specified under various schedules in this Act and shall include a special levy on value added products to promote the growth of the industry, factories and shall include but is not limited to factory cess, mining cess, soapstone cess, bricks cess, sand cess, stone cess and all other related cesses; "Chief Officer" means County Chief Officer responsible for Finance and Economic Planning;

"County" means the County Government of Migori;

"Urban area" means a municipality or a town gazetted as per the urban areas and cities Act of 2011;

Towns under Municipalities for purposes of this Act shall be construed to include the following areas—

"Contribution in lieu of rates (CILOR)" means a charge payable by government agencies to the Migori County Government for the spaces they occupy;

"County Revenue Collector" means the County Public Officer appointed pursuant to section 158 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 for the purpose of collecting revenue for the County Government and remitting it to the County Receiver of Revenue;

"County Revenue Officer" means overall officer in charge of revenue in the County;

"Executive Member" means Executive Committee Member for Finance and Economic Planning;

"Factory" means an industrial site where workers manufacture goods or operate machine processing one product to another;

"Levy" means various taxes, fees and other service charges that are imposed and payable to the County Government of Migori;

"Licence" shall refer to authorization for any person to conduct a particular business or line of business within a certain jurisdiction in the County;

"Permit" shall refer to license granted or issued by the County Government of Migori to any business operating within Migori County;

"Person" shall mean a natural or artificial or juristic person;

"Transporter" A person or thing that ferries or moves something; a vehicle used or hired to carry goods and commodities from one point to another;

"Distributor" An agent or entity who supplies goods to retailers for resale purposes;

"Sub-County Revenue Officer" means Officer in charge of revenue mobilization and collection at the Sub-County;

"Ward Code" means the unique numbers given to the County Wards;

"Tax" shall refer to a compulsory financial contribution imposed by the County Government of Migori within its jurisdiction;

"Treasury" means the County Treasury of Migori.

Specification of terms or meaning

- 3. That in order to have a smooth, transparent and equitable levy system for purposes of Schedule 1 and 3 the following meanings have been assigned to the following terms where not specified—
 - (a) "Kiosk" means a temporary structure occupying space equal to or less than 100sq. ft.
 - (b) "Mini Trader" shall be a business person occupying space of 101-224 sq. ft.
 - (c) "Small Trader/Dealer" shall be a business person occupying space of 225sq.ft
 - (d) "Medium Trader" shall be a business person occupying from 226sq.ft but below 625sq.ft
 - (e) "Large Trader" shall be a business person occupying space 626-2500sq. ft.
 - (f) "Mega" shall be a business person occupying space between 2501-10,000sq.ft.
 - (g) Hypermarkets shall be a business person occupying over 10,000 sq. ft.
 - (h) Small School, 1-100 students.
 - (i) Medium School, 101-499 students.
 - (j) Large School above 500 students.
 - (k) The term "School" shall refer to and include Early Childhood Development Education Centres, Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary and Driving Schools.

- (1) The term "Higher Learning Institutions" shall refer to and include Colleges, Technical Institutes and Universities.
- (m) The County shall seek to seal all loopholes that promote corruption tax evasion and loss of revenue.

Licences and Other Fees

4 The County Treasury shall collect revenue within its area of jurisdiction for its recurrent expenditure, development and operation as hereunder.

Property Rates

5. The County shall charge property tax or levy rates on prime property in Migori Town, and other areas based on valuation under the Valuation for Rating Act (refer Schedule 8).

Other Cess

- **6.** (1) There shall be a levy to be known as Bricks, hard-Core, Ballast, Murram, sand Harvesting, Farm Produce, Jaggery, Poles, Timber Cess among others from source to be levied at designated point of the County and to be pegged on the vehicle tonnage ferrying the products (refer Schedule 5 for Migori Town for Schedule 4 of Sub-County).

- (3) The County Executive Committee Member may review the designated points from time to time by abolishing any existing point or introducing new ones. Any change of designated points shall be notified to the public through any appropriate mode of communication including a notice in the *County Gazette*.

Entertainment

- 7. (1) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance shall cause to be listed all social halls, stadia for purpose of controlling and supervising their use.
- (2) There shall be a data bank of all social amenities as per paragraph (a) above which shall be named by personnel answerable to Chief Officer.
- (3) To hire the social hall(s), stadia or other amenities shall attract a fee which is provided for in schedule 7.
- (4) Booking of social amenities e.g. Stadia is constructed to be effectively in force upon making the use, hire and or alternative events untenable in the same venue.
- (5) The point at which the venue is made available to alternative use or users shall be construed to the last day of un-pitching from the venue

Levies, Fees and Charges, Payable and Rates Applicable

- **8.** (1) The levies, fees and charges set out in the "Charges" column of the Schedules shall apply for the respective items listed in the code column "Items Description" Column and at the rates set out therein.
- (2) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance shall give guidelines on how the levies, fees and charges can be adjusted in consultation with Revenue Officers and other stakeholders.

Accountability and Transparency

- **9.** (1)The Executive Member for Finance shall set targets on revenue collections with the chief officer responsible for finance.
- (2) There shall be proper documentation of all cash collected as revenue on behalf of the County by the Revenue Officers and there shall be put in place cash registers.
- (3) It shall constitute an offence for any revenue Officer to divert, or incur financial loss due to dishonesty, incompetence or malpractice for money received as revenue from the public for the County Government.
- (4) To protect its revenue bases, the executive Committee Member for Finance shall take up the existing Revenue Collection Centres already in the Sub-Counties and with such modifications as may be deemed necessary.

- (5) Revenue Officer is the designated officer responsible for mobilisation and collection of revenue. Such an officer may be deployed at the Sub County, department and ward—
- (6) Ward revenue officer shall be answerable to the sub county revenue officer;
- (7) All sub county and departmental revenue officers shall be answerable to the county revenue officer;
- (8) County revenue officer shall be answerable to the chief officer responsible to finance.
- (9) All debts owed to the defunct local authorities shall be recovered with 15% interest and paid to the County Government.
- (10) Any person who misappropriates steals or spends without authority shall be held personally responsible and shall be dealt with administratively.

Transitional and Consequential Provisions

- **10.** (1) That any permit or receipt issued under the by-laws contemplated herein and were valid before the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to be valid and issued under this Act.
 - (2) This Act shall continue to be applicable until it is repealed.
- (3) All businesses that continuously, seasonally or at known intervals operate shall be required to register.
- (4) A business register shall be maintained at the sub county. A summarised and collated register of all registered businesses shall be maintained at the county headquarters.

Powers of entry and seizure

- 11. (1) A designated officer may at any reasonable time inspect any premises for the purposes of trade, to enforce compliance of this Act.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1), a designated officer may enter any shop, factory, store or warehouse, stall, yard or other premises wherein he has reasonable cause to believe that requirements of this act has been breached and enforcement is necessary.

Powers of arrest, search and seizure

12. In addition to any other powers conferred by this Act, a designated officer shall have the following powers—

- (a) he may stop and detain, or may arrest without warrant, any person suspected of an offence under this Act or which he has reason to believe that such an offence has been committed and may search any person so stopped and detained or arrested;
- (b) he may seize and detain any goods or thing, of which he has reason to believe that an offence under this Act has been committed or which he has reason to believe to be evidence of such an offence: Provided that no person shall be arrested under this section unless he obstructs or hinders the officer or it appears to the officer that such a person is likely to fail to answer to a summons, or such a person refuses to give his name and address to the officer and to produce to him satisfactory evidence of his identity, or such person gives a name and address which the officer has reason to believe to be false.

Employer answerable for acts of servant, etc.

13. Any person who employs in his shop, store, or other place of business any agent, servant, or other person shall be answerable for the acts or omissions of the agent, servant or other person in so far as they concern the business of the employer and if such agent, servant or other person commits any act or makes any omission which is an offence if committed or made by such employer, such employer and his agent, servant or other person shall each be guilty of the offence and shall be jointly and severally liable to the penalties provided by this Act.

Liability of partners in a firm

14. Any partner in any firm shall be answerable for the acts or omissions of any other partner in the same firm in so far as they concern that firm; and if any partner commits any act or makes any omission which is an offence under this Act, every partner in the firm shall be jointly and severally liable to the penalties provided by this Act.

Disposal of seized goods

- **15.** (1) Where any vehicle, instrument, goods, articles or money has been seized under this Act, the same may be retained for a period not exceeding three months or if, within that period; proceedings are commenced for any offence under this Act, until the final determination of those proceedings.
- (2) Where any goods are seized and detained under this Act, they shall be returned, less any portion which has been reasonably utilized for the purpose of any tests, to the person from whom they were seized within a period of three months after the date of seizure unless within such period some person is charged with an offence under this Act and

such offence was committed in relation to or in connection with such goods.

- (3) Where any perishable goods have been seized under any provision of this Act, the officer who has seized the goods shall forthwith report to a magistrate the fact of the seizure and if the Magistrate is satisfied that the goods are perishable, he may authorize the officer to dispose of the goods as the Magistrate may think fit.
- (4) Where any proceedings are taken for any offence under this Act, the Court by or before which the alleged offender is tried may make such order as to the forfeiture of the goods in respect of which such offence was committed or as to the disposal of any goods or money seized in connection therewith as the court shall see fit.
- (5) Where animals are the subject of seizure, the retention period shall be three days provided with water and basic feeds at the expense of the owner. After elapse of three days without the owners initiating recovery the impounding officer shall under this Act be authorized to dispose them off at the nearest auction at a cost commensurate to the status of the animals.
- (6) A seizure certificate shall be issued to the person from whom the articles are seized and shall be in a prescribed form. A register of seized goods shall be maintained.

Offences

- **16.** (1) Any person or licensee who gives false information or makes false statement either orally or in writing in connection with a call of information made under this Act or in connection with an investigation into the commission of an offence under this Act, or abets the commission of the offence shall be guilty of an offence.
- (2). Any person found guilty under section 1(a) above shall be liable to fine not exceeding **Fifty Thousand or a jail term of three years or both.**
- (3) Any person who operates unregistered business shall be guilty of an offence.
- (4) Any person who obstructs or hinders or assaults a designated officer in the performance of any duty or act imposed or authorized by this Act or who fails to comply with any reasonable request made by a designated officer in the course of his duty under this Act, shall be guilty of an offence.

(5) Anybody who parks any article, picks passengers, exposes goods for sale, disposes refuse and performs any function at non-designated place shall be guilty of an offence.

Rules

17. The Executive Committee Member for Finance in consultation with the County Executive Committee shall make rules to regulate the enforcement of the provisions of this Act with approval of the County Assembly.

PART VIII—MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Operational Boundaries for the Act

18. The Migori County Finance Act, 2020 shall be operational within the boundaries demarcated as Migori County by National Legislation.

Regulations

- **19.** (1) The Executive Committee Member for Finance may make regulations for better carrying out of the functions under this Act for purposes of revenue collection.
- (2) The Executive Committee Member for Finance and the County Chief Officer responsible for Finance Officer shall design the format for, forms, receipts, permits, licenses, invoice, demand notice and registers for revenue collection which are tamper proof.
- (3) For avoidance of doubt the Executive Committee Member for Finance and the County Chief Finance Officer shall issue unique Business Codes in respect of all areas of revenue collection.
- (4) In computation of time, reference to hour, day, month, year shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Procedure Act Cap. 21 Laws of Kenya and Article 259 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010.
- (5) Revenue collection in this Act as a 24-hour activity in the whole County. Enforcement of this Act is at any reasonable time.
- (6) The Executive Committee Member for Finance in consultation with the County Executive Committee and the approval of the County Assembly may make rules and regulations to accord people living with disability a tax holiday in its revenue collection, however this applies to waiver of not more than one business unit.

Penalties

- **20.** (1) To effect and ensure compliance with this Act and more specifically on the payment of the levies, fees, and charges as per the schedules provided herein it is enacted as hereunder.
 - (2) For administrative, supervision and inspectorate purposes—
 - (a) The County shall carryout registration of all Businesses and Properties within Migori County. Failure to register will attract a penalty as per the approved fees and charges.
 - (b) Single Business Permit issued expires on 31st December of every year but failure to apply and obtain a Single Business Permit by the 31st March of each year, the fees chargeable shall attract a penalty of 30% of the invoiced amount.
 - (c) That failure by a factory to remit cess as required within the stipulated period the unpaid cess shall attract a penalty of 5% on the total cess withheld quarterly.
 - (d) That the harvesting of sand, hard-core, murram and other royalties shall only be permitted after taking into consideration all relevant approval on environmental and public safety concerns from relevant bodies.
 - (e) That it shall be an offence to excavate, dig and or mine any of the products named in (d) above without due regard to environmental and public safety concerns.
- (3) Any person who commits an offence under this Act for which no penalty is provided shall be liable, to a fine not exceeding Fifty Thousand Shillings or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

General Penalty

21. Any person found guilty of an offence under this Act shall be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty thousand or to an imprisonment term not exceeding one year or both.

PART IX-AMENDMENT TO THE SCHEDULES

Amendment of Schedules

22. The Executive Committee Member for Finance may by order published in the Gazette amend any of the schedules. Any order made under section (11) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the order is passed by the County Assembly within Forty-Five Days when the Assembly next sits after the order is so laid, the order shall lapse, but without prejudice to anything previously done there under.

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Bill confers a general power and responsibility for the administration of county revenue laws on the receiver of revenue who is to be held accountable for that administration.

To achieve this purpose, the Bill sets out additional administrative and enforcement provisions relating to revenue legislation.

Article 209 (3) of the constitution provides for the imposition of property rates by the county governments.

The Bill gives effect to that exclusive county taxing power by providing for the imposition and collection of property rates. The bill relies on the property valuations in place under the national Valuation for Rating Act (Cap. 266).

Article 209 (4) of the Constitution together with part 2 of the Forth Schedule of the Constitution gives counties the power to impose fees and charges for services provided and for regulatory purposes in respect of certain licensed activities.

These licensing powers are not taxing powers, but are power to charge fees for services.

The Bill provides for the grant of trade licenses by the County Government of Migori to conduct businesses in the county in accordance with powers mentioned above in Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution.

The enactment of this Bill into law does not occasion additional expenditure of public funds.
